

**NOTICE IS GIVEN** that on **Wednesday, January 16, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.**, prevailing time, Council for the Borough of West Chester, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing as part of the regular monthly public meeting at the Borough of West Chester's municipal building located at 401 East Gay Street, West Chester, Pennsylvania, to consider the adoption of, and if approved, Borough Council will adopt an ordinance adopting the real estate tax rate for 2019. The Ordinance has the following title:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER,  
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO ADOPT THE  
REAL ESTATE TAX RATE.**

Pursuant to the Local Tax Enabling Act, 53 P.S. §6924.101 *et seq.*, notice is given that the ordinance would impose the following real estate taxes:

The amount of revenue estimated to be derived from these taxes for fiscal year 2019 is approximately \$5,251,466 for general purposes and debt and \$115,671 for library purposes.
