

NOTICE IS GIVEN that on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., prevailing time, Council for the Borough of West Chester, Chester County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing as part of the regularly scheduled public meeting at the Borough of West Chester's municipal building located at 401 East Gay Street, West Chester, Pennsylvania, to consider the adoption of, and if approved, Borough Council will adopt amendments to the Borough Code with the following title and summary:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOUROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 104 TITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," SECTION 104-32 TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF WEST MARKET STREET AND POPLAR STREET DURING CERTAIN DAYS OF THE WEEK AND HOURS OF THE DAY; SECTION 104-45 TO REMOVE THE HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES AT 118 WEST BARNARD STREET AND 404 NORTH DARLINGTON STREET AND TO ADOPT A NEW SECTION 104-34.1 TO PROHIBIT PARKING IN A PARKING SPOT DESIGNATED BY THE BOROUGH AS AN ELECTRIC CHARGING STATION IF THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS NOT CONNECTED TO THE CHARGING STATION.
