3. Consider awarding the HVAC maintenance contract to NexGen Automation, Inc. 4501 Chambers Hill Road, Harrisburg, PA 17111 for Borough facilities. The recommended contract period of three (3) years at a cost of \$20,915.00 per year for all facilities/buildings listed on the proposal. (**attachment**)
4. Discuss pending bid opening for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Soda Ash.
