

ORDINANCE NO. 01 -2021

BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER

CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 104 TITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," SECTION 104-20 TO CREATE A NEW SUBSECTION B TO PERMIT MUNICIPAL VEHICLES TO TRAVEL ON BRADFORD AVENUE BETWEEN ROSEDALE AVENUE AND STRASBURG ROAD AND SECTION 104-45 TO ADD A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE AT 526 NORTH DARLINGTON STREET.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it hereby enacted by authority of the Council of the Borough of West Chester, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 104 of the Code of the Borough of West Chester, titled "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 104-20, titled "Certain classes of vehicles prohibited on certain highways", is hereby amended to add a new subsection B which shall read as follows:

- B. Notwithstanding the provisions in Section 104-20.A above, all municipal vehicles owned and operated by the Borough of West Chester, East Bradford Township, or their agents or designees shall be permitted at any time on the following roads through the Borough of West Chester:

| Highway | Between |
|--------------------|--|
| N. Bradford Avenue | Northbound lane from Market Street to Rt. 162 (Strasburg Road) |
| S. Bradford Avenue | Northbound lane from Rosedale Avenue to Market Street |

SECTION 2. Chapter 104 of the Code of the Borough of West Chester, titled "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 104-20, titled "Certain classes of vehicles prohibited on certain highways", is hereby amended to renumber Section 104-20.B to be Section 104-20.C.

SECTION 3. Chapter 104 of the Code of the Borough of West Chester, titled, "Vehicles and Traffic," Section 104-45, titled, "Special purpose parking zones established; parking otherwise prohibited," is hereby amended **TO ADD** the following:

| Highway | Side | Location | Authorized Purpose or Vehicle |
|-------------------|------|-----------------------|---|
| Darlington Street | West | 526 N. Darlington St. | 1 parking space for handicapped persons |

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council of the Borough of West Chester that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included therein.

SECTION 5. REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment as provided by law.


